<p>In light of the above evaluation and examiner’s confidence in the examinee, the following votes to certify or defer are made. The total average score must be at least <b>48</b> in order to be certified. If the candidate receives a score of 1 in any one category from ALL the examiners, deferral is automatic. If two examiners vote to defer, the candidate is deferred (no process facilitator is called). The candidate may request that the Chairperson call in a process facilitator at any point before the individual board members begin to score. This point is to be announced by the board chairperson, who will ask the board if they are ready to being scoring. After this point ONLY the board members (including the chair) thought the Chairperson can call for a process facilitator. The process facilitator will establish a clear contract with the board and will help the board reach a decision. If no decision to certify or defer is reached, the examination supervisor can be called. The examination supervisor can help the board reach a decision or can excuse the board and convene a new board to re-examine the candidate. Neither the process facilitator nor the examination supervisor can examine or vote.</p> <p>Examiners must consider whether they would refer supervisees to the candidate.
