Tasks and responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The EATA delegate to EAP will attend the yearly EATA council meeting in July, and attend the PTSC or Executive meetings when is necessary. • She/he will send a regular report for the PTSC meeting in March and November to the President of EATA. • The EATA delegate to EAP will need to be present and active at EAP meetings 2 times a year in order to give Transactional analysis its place • She/he is a member of EWOC (European Wide Organization Committee) • She/he will inform EATA through regular reports of new decisions or evolutions in EAP • If she/he as delegate is unable to attend meetings for certain reasons, she/he will propose another person to EATA executive who will be the deputy in all these cases. • She/he will ask EATA to adapt its own regulations to EAP requisites, in order to receive EAP recognition, e.g. concerning recognition of TA training institutes for Psychotherapy, which will award ECP • She/he will represent EATA' opinion – after collecting opinions by internal mailing process with EATA through the liaison person concerning any important decisions like accepting a new modality of psychotherapy. • She/he will sign the recommendation for getting ECP / European Certificate for Psychotherapy/ for CTA's in psychotherapy
